



## Pre-K Classroom Lesson

### Paul and Silas

#### Acts 16:16-40



### This Month's Memory

Your word is truth.  
John 17:17 NIV

### Introduction:

As students come in, please hand out the coloring page. If the students don't want to color they can play, do puzzles, or draw.

### Lesson:

Have the students sit in a circle on the floor.

- Say this month's memory verse with the students. **Your word is truth. John 17:17 NIV**

### Discussion questions:

1. Who does the true Bible story begin with? (Two men named Paul and Silas.)
2. What did Paul and Silas tell everyone everywhere? (That Jesus wanted to be their friend forever.)
3. How did the people who did not love Jesus try to stop Paul and Silas? (They put Paul and Silas in jail.)
4. What did Paul and Silas know? (That even though they were in jail, God still loved them, and they could pray and talk to God.)
5. What happened while Paul and Silas were praying and singing in the jail? (There was an earthquake.)
6. Did Paul and Silas leave when the earthquake shook the jail and the doors of the jail flew wide open? (No.)
7. What did Paul and Silas do after the earthquake stopped? (They spoke to the guard who was in charge of the jail.)
8. Why did the guard decide to love God and follow Jesus? (Paul and Silas told the him that God loves him and that Jesus wants to be his friend forever. )
9. What did Paul and Silas know? (That they could pray and talk to God anytime, anywhere, and about anything.)
10. What does the Bible teach us? (The best things!)

### Prayer:

Dear God, thank you for giving us the Bible so we can learn more about you. Thank you for hearing us when we pray. Help us remember that we can always talk to you—anytime, anywhere and about anything. We pray in Jesus' name. Amen.

### Craft:

Give students the Paul and Silas paper, and the four pictures of Paul and Silas. Have students color the four pictures. After students are done coloring have them glue the four pictures on the Paul and Silas paper in order of how the story was. Once students are done they will have a paper telling the story of Paul and Silas.
