Acts 9:36-39; 1 Timothy 4:12



This Month's Memory

Your word is truth.

John 17:17 NIrV

Introduction:

As students come in, please hand out the coloring page. If the students don't want to color they can play, do puzzles, or draw.

Lesson:

Have the students sit in a circle on the floor.

- Say this month's memory verse with the students. **Your word is truth. John 17:17 NIrV**

Discussion questions:

1. **Who is the first true story from the Bible about?** (A woman named Tabitha.)
2. **Why did Tabitha want to live for God?** (She loved Him.)
3. **What is one way Tabitha lived for God?** (By helping people.)
4. **How did Tabitha help people?** (She made clothes for people to wear.)
5. **Who is the second true story from the Bible about?** (A young man named Timothy.)
6. **Why did Timothy want to live for God?** (He loved God.)
7. **Was Timothy young?** (Yes.)
8. **What did Timothy tell people?** (That God loved them.)
9. **What did Timothy teach people?** (He taught them about God and how to love like Jesus.)
10. **Who did Timothy live for?** (God.)
11. **What do the Bible stories about Tabitha and Timothy show us?** (That we can do what God says and be like Jesus.)
12. **What does the Bible teach us?** (The best things!)

Prayer:

Dear God, thank you for giving us the Bible. We can read about people like Tabitha and Timothy and how they helped people. You're the best God! We pray in Jesus' name. Amen

Craft:

Give students the Timothy and Tabitha paper, a piece of cloth and a wooden heart. Have students color the Timothy and Tabitha paper. After students are done coloring have them put the wooden heart on Timothy's sash and have them glue the piece of cloth on Tabitha's lap. Once the students are done they will have a paper with Tabitha sewing and Timothy loving.
