



Philip Acts 8:26-35

Memory Verse:
Your word is truth.
John 17:17 NIV

The true story from the Bible begins with a man named Philip. Philip loved God, and he was friends with Jesus, God's Son.

One day, an angel told Philip to walk down a road, and when Philip did he saw a chariot! A chariot is a fancy cart pulled by a large animal, like an ox or a horse.

God told Philip to go to the chariot, so Philip stopped walking and ran up to the chariot.

When Philip got to the chariot, he could hear a man reading God's words. Philip asked him: "Do you understand what you're reading?" (Acts 8:30 NIV).

The man said: "How can I? I need someone to explain it to me." (Acts 8:31 NIV)

So, Philip sat with the man in the chariot. They read God's words together, and Philip helped him understand God's words.

Philip told him the good news about Jesus (Acts 8:35 NIV) and that Jesus wanted to be his friend forever.

Philip helped the man understand God's words so he could hear from God.

The Bible teaches us the best things!

Questions:

- **Who does the true story from the Bible begin with?** (A man named Philip who loved God.)
- **What did an angel tell Philip to do?** (Walk down a road.)
- **What did Philip see when he walked down the road?** (He saw a chariot.)
- **What is a chariot?** (A fancy cart pulled by a large animal,

like an ox or a horse.)

- **Why did Philip stop walking and run up to the chariot?** (God told him to.)
- **What did Philip ask the man when he got to the chariot?** ("Do you understand what you're reading?" Acts 8:30 NIV).
- **What did the man say?** ("How can I? I need someone to explain it to me." Acts 8:31 NIV)
- **What did Philip do?** (He sat with the man in the chariot and helped him understand God's words.)
- **What did Philip tell the man in the chariot?** (The good news about Jesus and that Jesus wanted to be his friend forever.)
- **What does the Bible teach us?** (The best things!)

Prayer:

Dear God, thank You so much for giving us the Bible. You give us people who help us hear from you when we read the Bible. Help us learn more about you, God. We pray in Jesus' name. Amen.

Parent Cue:

- **Morning Time:** When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning! God tell us in the Bible that His mercy is new every day."
- **Cuddle Time:** Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, help us remember that the Bible shows us what we should do."
- **Drive Time:** While on the go, point out different street signs and how they tell us what to do. Say: "God's Word also tells us what to do."
- **Bath Time:** Bring two action figures into the bathtub and have your child pretend that one of the figures is telling the other one about Jesus, just like Philip told the man he met on the road.
