



Tabitha and Timothy

Acts 9:36-39; 1 Timothy 4:12

Memory Verse:
Your word is truth.
John 17:17 NIrV

The first true story from the Bible is about a woman named Tabitha.

Tabitha loved God, and she wanted to live for God.

One way Tabitha lived for God was by helping people.

Tabitha made clothes for people to wear.

Tabitha made a lot of clothes! She helped a lot of people.

The next true story from the Bible is about a young man named Timothy.

Timothy loved God and wanted to live for God, too.

And even though Timothy was young, he taught others about God. Timothy told people that God loved them.

Timothy taught people about God and showed them how to love like Jesus. Timothy lived for God!

These Bible stories about Tabitha and Timothy show us that we can do what God says and be like Jesus.

The Bible has God's words in it, and it teaches us the best things!

Questions:

- **Who is the first true story from the Bible about?** (A woman named Tabitha.)
- **Why did Tabitha want to live for God?** (She loved Him.)
- **What is one way Tabitha lived for God?** (By helping people.)
- **How did Tabitha help people?** (She made clothes for people to wear.)

- **Who is the second true story from the Bible about?** (A young man named Timothy.)
- **Why did Timothy want to live for God?** (He loved God.)
- **Was Timothy young?** (Yes.)
- **What did Timothy tell people?** (That God loved them.)
- **What did Timothy teach people?** (He taught them about God and how to love like Jesus.)
- **Who did Timothy live for?** (God.)
- **What do the Bible stories about Tabitha and Timothy show us?** (That we can do what God says and be like Jesus.)
- **What does the Bible teach us?** (The best things!)

Prayer:

Dear God, thank you for giving us the Bible. We can read about people like Tabitha and Timothy and how they helped people. You're the best God! We pray in Jesus' name. Amen.

Parent Cue:

- **Morning Time:** When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning! God tells us in the Bible that He loves us so much!"
- **Cuddle Time:** Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, thank You that Your Word, the Bible, is true."
- **Drive Time:** While on the go, ask your child what is their favorite story. Then say: "The Bible is filled with a lot of stories that are true and tell us about how awesome God is."
- **Bath Time:** As you give your child a bath, ask them: "Who are the people who help you?" Explain how Tabitha and Timothy lived for God and helped people.
