This Month's Memory

How you made me is amazing and wonderful.
Psalm 139:14 NIrV

Introduction:

As students come in, please hand out the coloring page. If the students don't want to color they can play, do puzzles, or draw.

Lesson:

Have the students sit in a circle on the floor .

- Say this month's memory verse with the students. **How you made me is amazing and wonderful. Psalm 139:14 NIrV**

Discussion questions:

1. **Where does the true Bible story from the come from?** (The book of John.)
2. **What did God make?** (The whole world and everything we see.)
3. **Why did God give us a special gift?** (Because He loves us.)
4. **What special gift did God give us?** (Jesus.)
5. **Who is Jesus?** (God's Son.)
6. **What does Jesus want?** (To be our friend forever.)
7. **What does the Bible teach us?** (That, God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son John 3:16 NIrV).
8. **Who is a gift for every person God made?** (Jesus.)
9. **Who made us?** (God.)

Prayer:

Dear God, thank You for giving us the greatest gift ever ... Jesus! You made us and love us so much that You gave us Your Son. That is wonderful and amazing. Thank You that we don't have to do anything to earn your love. Thank You for the amazing gift of Jesus. We love You so much. We pray in Jesus' name, Amen.

Craft:

Give students a heart, small Jesus, and some string. Have students color the heart. After students are done coloring the heart have them draw a self portrait on the inside of the heart. Once the students are done drawing a self portrait have them glue the small Jesus on the other side of the inside of the heart. Then have the students put a string though both holes of the heart. Students will then have a locket necklace with a picture of them and Jesus inside.
